## Working paper – Transmission pricing methodology: Sunk costs

A path to effectively coalesce all this work is needed because, as NZIER note (refer last sentence of their letter) "... without an appropriately defined and agreed problem definition that is assessed through a fit-for-purpose cost-benefit analysis, the disagreements about the efficiency of the proposed TPM and the potential for unintended outcomes will remain, regardless of the clarity that is gained around these principles."
